

# Ice Safety Rescue Technician Level 3- Technician

# **Course Overview**

Ice Safety Rescue Technician Level 3 course is designed for those that are required to operate on higher risk flat/static ice and moving ice. The training is for personal safety and knowledge to perform complex operational and safety tasks on the ice and/or un-tethered in higher risk static and dynamic ice environments.

- Agency and task specific

## **Registration/Cancelation**

Registration is done via the website or office. You will be charged a \$100.00 (plus tax) non-refundable deposit at time of registration. This will register you into the course and give you access to the Swiftwater Safety Rescue Awareness eLearning course. This eLearning course must be completed before the first day of the training course.

# Greater than 14 days' notice of cancellation (Student)

Course Tuition:

• When full course tuition has been paid the tuition less the deposit will be returned.

#### **Rental Fee**

- If rental equipment has not been shipped there will be a full refund.
- If rental equipment has been shipped the rental fee will be refunded minus \$25.00 restocking fee and shipping expenses.

## Less than 14 days (Student)

Course Tuition:

• No refund. A portion of the course tuition can be used for a Rescue Canada course within 1 year.

Rental Fee

## Absent/Incomplete

When a registered student does not show up for the course, the full tuition will still be charged, and the student does not qualify for any refund. Student(s) that are unsuccessful or incomplete in the course do not qualify for a refund.
