

# Helicopter Safety Rescue Technician Level 1

## Safety & Survival

### Course Overview

Helicopter Safety Rescue Technician Level 1 course was developed to give students the framework for crash survival. Rescue Canada has developed this practical helicopter underwater egress training (HUET) to give the students the necessary tools to survive in the event of a crash both in the water and on land. Rescue Canada uses 3 dunkers to provide the students practical training in a simple to complex environment. This course also includes Spare Air training.

### Course Objectives

By the end of this course the student will have the following understanding:

- Helicopter theory and absolutes
- Emergency planning
- Risk assessment and responsibility
- Personal protective equipment
- Pre-crash
- Post-Crash
- Spare Aid (HABD)
- Helicopter Underwater Egress Training
- Agency and task specific

Completion of Helicopter Awareness Course (included)  
Good Health and Able to Swim

- Flight Helmets

- Bathing suit and towel
- Thermal Protection (optional but recommended wetsuit)

## **Training Format**

Training will be half day plus eLearning:

- eLearning will be sent approximately 2 weeks prior to training and is to be completed prior to the course
- Half day practical training in the pool setting

## **Completion/Certification**

Helicopter Safety Rescue Technician Level 1

- Rescue Canada and IRIA Certified
- Valid for 2 years

### **Registration/Cancelation**

Registration is done via the website or office. You will be charged a \$100.00 (plus tax) non-refundable deposit at time of registration. This will register you into the course and give you access to the Swiftwater Safety Rescue Awareness eLearning course. This eLearning course must be completed before the first day of the training course.

### **Greater than 14 days' notice of cancellation (Student)**

Course Tuition:

- When full course tuition has been paid the tuition less the deposit will be returned.

Rental Fee

- If rental equipment has not been shipped there will be a full refund.
- If rental equipment has been shipped the rental fee will be refunded minus \$25.00 restocking fee and shipping expenses.

### **Less than 14 days (Student)**

Course Tuition:

- No refund. A portion of the course tuition can be used for a Rescue Canada course within 1 year.

Rental Fee

- If rental equipment has been shipped there is no refund.
- If rental equipment has not been shipped there will be a refund minus \$25.00 restocking fee.

### **Absent/Incomplete**

When a registered student does not show up for the course, the full tuition will still be charged, and the student does not qualify for any refund. For extenuating circumstances such as injury (with proof if requested) a refund less the deposit can be requested. Student(s) that are unsuccessful or incomplete in the course do not qualify for a refund.
