

# Helicopter Safety Rescue Technician Level 2 Operations

## Course Overview

This training is Rescue Canada's industry standard for hover exit/entry and includes the Helicopter Awareness courses. This course is customized for emergency responders and industry workers that require improvised exit/entry procedure. Upon completion of the online awareness training students complete a one-day practical training session with performance-based skill. Upon completion of this training student will have the skills to safely perform hover exit and entries in most situations along with toe-ins, medical packaging and basic helicopter safety.

## Course Objectives

By the end of the course the students will have the following understanding:

- Helicopter theory and absolutes
- Site assessment and emergency planning
- Risk assessment and responsibility
- Personal protective equipment
- Communications
- Aircraft safety checks/briefing
- Equipment loading procedures (front cabin / back cargo area)
- Medical Packaging into a helicopter
- Landing Zones
- Hover entry/exit training procedures (blades not turning)
- Toe-in entry/exit (blades not turning)
- Briefing on Go-No-Go actions
- Hover entry/exit training (blades turning)
- Toe-in entry/exit (blades turning)
- Course debrief/conclusion
- Agency and task specific

Training will be 1 days plus eLearning:

- eLearning will be sent approximately 2 weeks prior to training and is to be completed prior to the course
- 1 days practical training

### **Completion/Certification**

### **Registration/Cancelation**

Registration is done via the website or office. You will be charged a \$100.00 (plus tax) non-refundable deposit at time of registration. This will register you into the course and give you access to the Helicopter Safety Rescue Awareness eLearning course. This eLearning course must be completed before the first day of the training course.

### **Greater than 14 days' notice of cancellation (Student)**

Course Tuition:

- When full course tuition has been paid the tuition less the deposit will be returned.

Rental Fee

- If rental equipment has not been shipped there will be a full refund.
- If rental equipment has been shipped the rental fee will be refunded minus \$25.00 restocking fee and shipping expenses.

### **Less than 14 days (Student)**

Course Tuition:

- No refund. A portion of the course tuition can be used for a Rescue Canada course within 1 year.

Rental Fee

- If rental equipment has been shipped there is no refund.
- If rental equipment has not been shipped there will be a refund minus \$25.00 restocking fee.

### **Absent/Incomplete**

When a registered student does not show up for the course, the full tuition will still be charged, and the student does not qualify for any refund. For extenuating circumstances such as injury (with proof if requested) a refund less the deposit can be requested. Student(s) that are unsuccessful or incomplete in the course do not qualify for a refund.

### **Rescue Canada Cancellation**

Rescue Canada reserves the right to cancel/reschedule any course due to, but not limited to, insufficient registrations or unsafe conditions. If Rescue Canada cancels a course, you will receive a full refund less the \$100.00 eLearning course/deposit. The student may choose to transfer their payment to a future course within 1 year.
