

Ice Safety Rescue Awareness – eLearning

Course Overview

Ice Safety Rescue Awareness course is designed for those that are required to operate near flat/static ice. The training is to provide theory knowledge of ice and risk involved with operating around and on flat/static and moving ice. This course is a prerequisite and included in all the Ice Safety Rescue Technician Levels. This course is designed for those that operate in the “cold zone”.

Completion/Certification

Upon completion of the course you can print your Certificate of Completion which is valid for 1 year.

Registration/Activation
