

# Swiftwater Safety Rescue Awareness – eLearning

## Course Overview

Swiftwater Safety Rescue Awareness course is designed to give basic understanding of the Swiftwater environment. This course is based on Swiftwater core principles and philosophies, risk assessment, hydrology and Swiftwater equipment. The course is a prerequisite and included in all the Swiftwater Safety Rescue Technician Levels. This course is designed for those that operate in the “cold zone”.

## Completion/Certification

Upon completion of the course you can print your Certificate of Completion which is valid for 1 year.

## Registration/Activation
